*Pseudopleuronectes americanus*

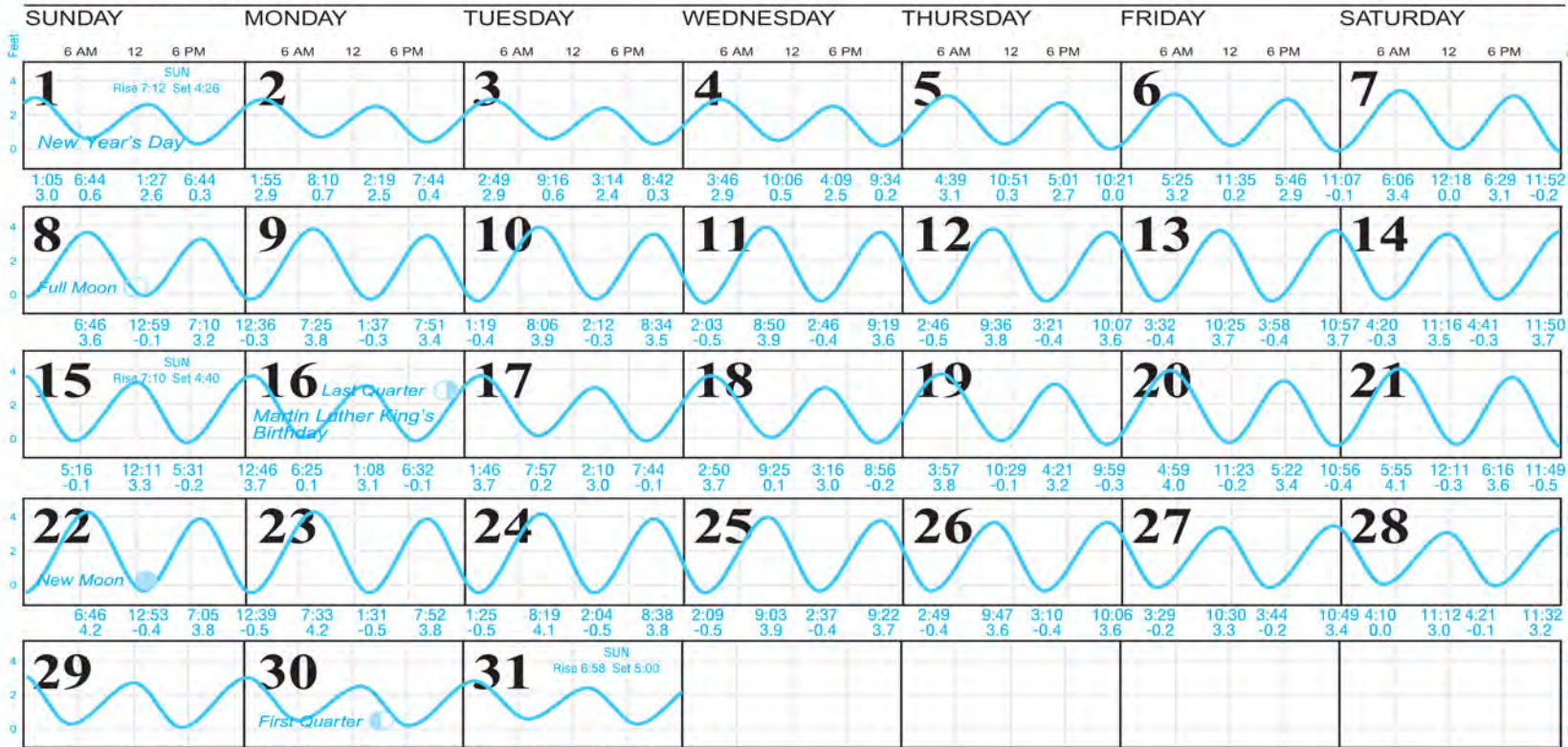
Once common throughout the Bay, recent stock assessments paint a disturbing downward population trend for the winter flounder. These declines, caused in large part by overfishing, habitat degradation and increased winter water temperatures in the Bay have led to strict fishing regulations in the hopes that the species will eventually rebound.
