

Partner in the Spotlight: W.ALTON JONES CAMP



The summer of 2008 saw the launch of a weeklong "Bay Mania" camp thanks to a partnership between the W. Alton Jones Camp of URI and the Narragansett Bay Research Reserve. Each week ten campers learn about Narragansett Bay, from its 1600 square mile watershed to the intricacies of its eelgrass beds. Campers spend three days on Prudence Island and are guided by the Reserve's naturalists. They have the opportunity to snorkel, use seine nets, set minnow traps, take part in hands-on field research projects, and explore the island's coastline to learn about the ecology of the Bay.
