



The Narragansett Bay Research Reserve is one of 27 Reserves in the **National Estuarine Research Reserve System**. This is a network of protected areas established for long-term research, education and stewardship of estuaries; **where the rivers meet the sea**. This partnership program between the National Oceanic Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) and the coastal states protects more than one million acres of estuarine land and water. The Reserve System provides essential habitat for wildlife; offers educational opportunities for students, teachers and the public; and serves as living laboratories for scientists.
